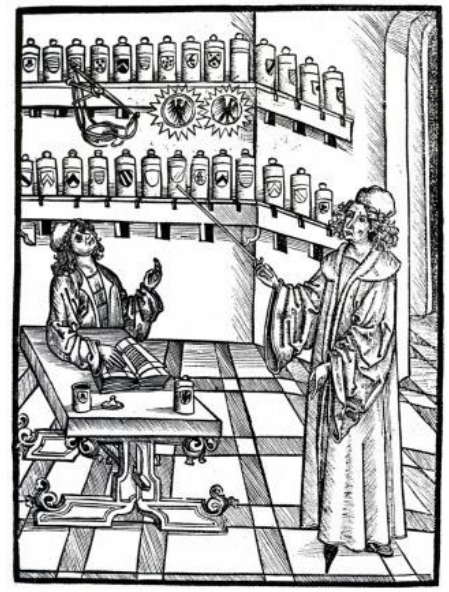


# The Apothecary



## Workshop Info

**Number of pupils taking part:** We can accommodate 2 classes in a day, with each class having a 1.5hr facilitated workshop, self-guided activities around the Barn, lunch break and medieval games.

**Age of pupils taking part:** KS2

**Times:** 10am – 2pm.

**Cost:** FREE to the first 3 schools! Then introductory rate of £2.50 per pupil (standard rate £5 per pupil).

**Who will run the workshops:** Jasmine Loveys - Community Engagement Officer at the Barn.

**What will pupils learn about:**

1. The Medieval approach to medicine.
2. Zodiac Man and the almanacs doctors used to diagnose patients.
3. Ailments from the time and the medicines used to treat them including mixing some herbal remedies.
4. Historical illuminated manuscripts. Pupils will make their own medieval inspired creative writing piece.
5. Botanical drawing in our kitchen garden.

**Curriculum links:**

English - Ask relevant questions to extend understanding and knowledge. Articulate and justify answers, arguments, and opinions.

Science - Identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: root, stem, trunk, leaves, and flowers. Make systematic and careful observations and take accurate measurements using standard units, using varied equipment.

Science- Identify body parts and systems.

History - Local history - a study of an aspect of history or a site dating from a period beyond 1066 that is significant in the locality.

Design and Technology - Select from and use a wider range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks. Generate and communicate ideas through discussion and annotated sketches.

Art and Design – Learn about great artists, craft makers, and designers in history. Use a range of materials to develop new technologies.
